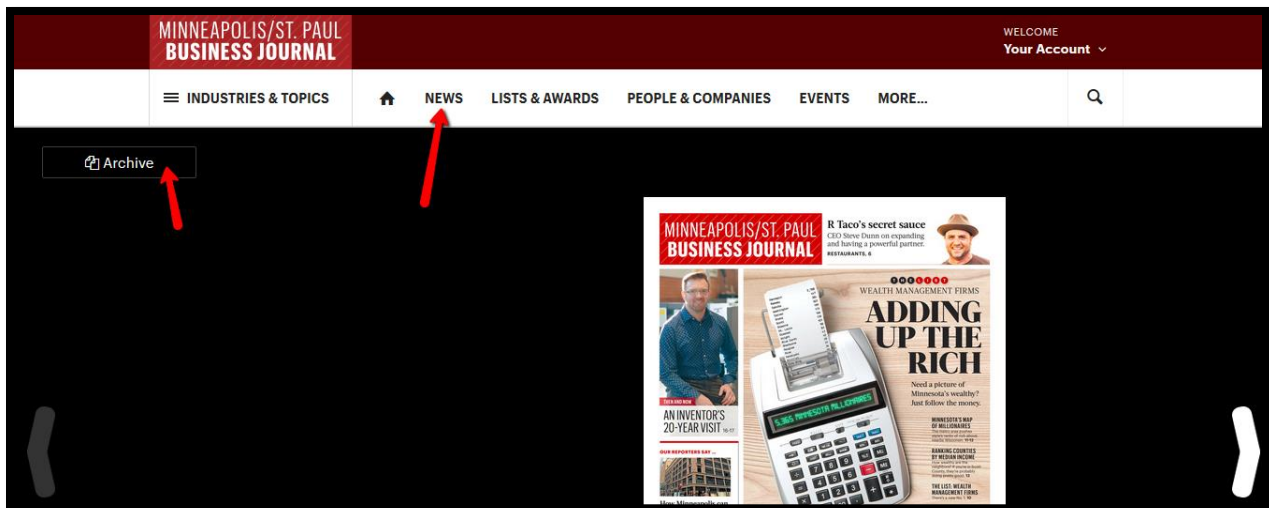

Access the database through the *Database List* page. Have a librarian log you in.

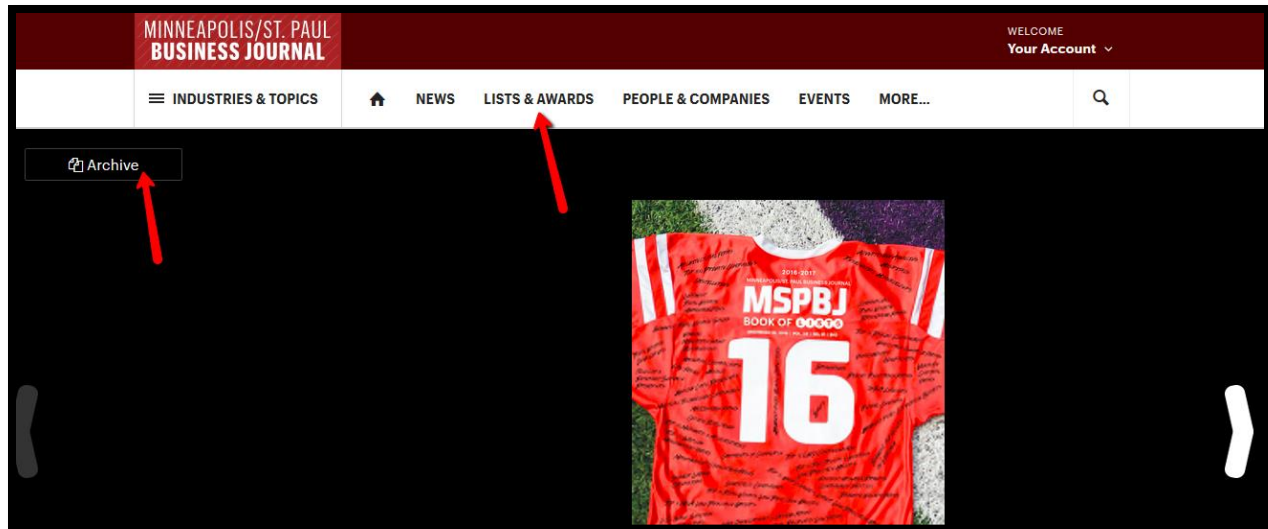
## READING ISSUES OF THE *MINNEAPOLIS/ST. PAUL BUSINESS JOURNAL*
